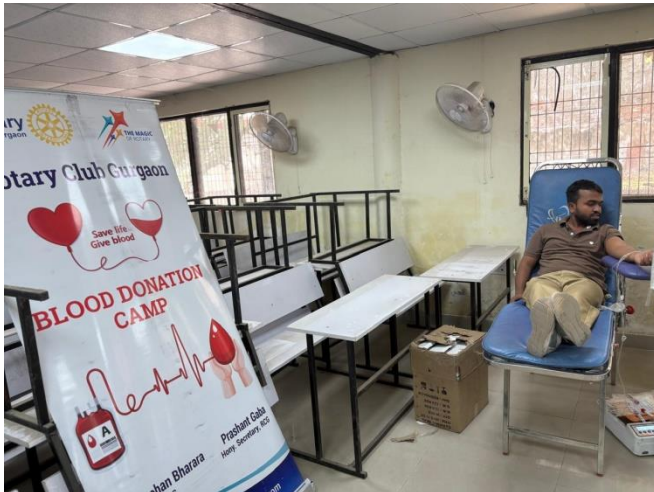
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12. Regular Club Meeting, Speaker Mr. Rajat Dhar

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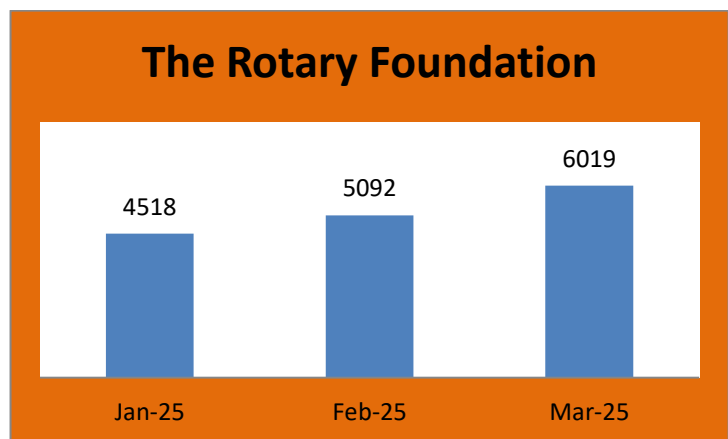
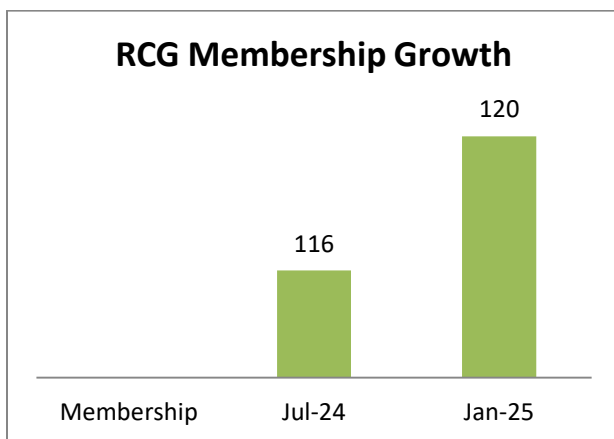
14. Donation for Thalassemia Patient Samridh Mirchandani
