3. Thalassemia Awareness & Screening, 8th May 2026

Our Rtn. Dr. Meet Kumar, Zonal Chair – Thalassaemia Awareness & Screening, participated in the Walkathon 2026 held at Nehru Park, New Delhi, where Rotarians, Rotaractors, Interactors, and social leaders united under the inspiring theme, “Walk for Life, Walk for Awareness.” The walk highlighted the importance of early screening, prevention, and support for individuals and families battling Thalassaemia.
